Goal #1	Goal: 92% of graduates will be on track for graduation upon completion of the ninth grade.
Short-Term Outcome	Our High School Success team, along with our middle school partners, will meet regularly to review data, supports and design/implement interventions geared for preparing our MS students for 9th grade readiness and 9th grade for successful course completion.
Long-Term Outcome	Student data will indicate our tracked preparatory programs, interventions, and credit recovery options have a direct impact on our 9th grader credit attainment rates.
Goal #2	We will increase/add at least five additional academic and experiential opportunities in Career and Technical Education on campus or on location for all 9th - 12th grade students.
Short-Term Outcome	9th -12th grade students will participate in industry tours, discussions and opportunities to increase their knowledge of post-secondary opportunities, programs and employment by May 2022.
Long-Term Outcome	Student graduation data and projected post-secondary employment will indicate an increase in students entering programs or employment in various CTE areas.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	We will hold 9th grade team meetings monthly. The team meetings will focus on data and alternate between looking at individual students in need of support and focusing on overall data to inform system changes and supports. The monies will be used for professional development, venue costs, and access to technology and supplies needed for meetings on and off campus.
