Goal #1	95% of students will be on-track toward graduation after completing 9th grade.
Short-Term Outcome	Ninth grade success teams (teachers and relevant support staff) are meeting regularly, looking at data, student supports are tracked for effectiveness and students and families are involved in the evaluation of those supports.
Long-Term Outcome	he overall 9th grade on-track rate of students will increase by 15% with the largest increases seen in focal student groups identified in the district needs assessment.
Goal #2	Students will develop and track post-secondary plans following graduation and will move along a deliberate path through school toward their preferred next steps in college or career.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers/Administrators/Career Counselors will actively encourage students who are members of groups of students not typically engaged in advanced coursework or career and technical courses to pursue these paths in accord with their post-secondary plans, as expressed in the student's education plan and profile.
Long-Term Outcome	Student enrollment in advanced coursework and career and technical courses will rise by 20% with the largest increases seen in focal student groups identified in the district needs assessment.
