<b>Goal #1</b>	Students will engage in project based Science horticulture program and curriculum on a path toward integration in their next step educational placement. This course allows students to earn community service and work credit, which is designed to engage students outside of the typical classroom.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	MLK staff plan for and deliver opportunities to encourage students with current or previous juvenile justice involvement to participate in our Science project based horticulture program. This develops job skills and competence to transition to high school CTE programs. This course allows students to earn community service and work credit, which is designed to engage students outside of the typical classroom.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	All students enrolled in MLK participate in the horticulture program through academic or youth community service. Attendance in academic courses is bolstered by robust community involvement for our youth. The goal is to increase individual attendance by 20% from where student was in their traditional placement.
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	Students will participate in native plant nursery project in collaboration with community partners including USFS, BLM, city and county park systems.
