They will be given support<br>for all graduation requirements and post-graduation planning, which will<br>include scholarship applications, resume and job readiness skill building,<br>military exploration, senior project support, community service support, and<br>leadership training.  |

| Long-Term<br>Outcome  | All graduating seniors will graduate with a post-graduation plan. Post graduating seniors will report that they were supported to their after high school life. (As evidenced by Lifetrack Surveys.)   |
| Goal #4               | Mapleton will offer Writing 115 and Writing 121 to qualifying juniors and seniors. There will be concerted efforts to make these courses accessible to all. There is a current disparity in the number of boys vs. girls taking the course, so an increase in gender equity will be a central focus.   |
