**Lead Organization**                      **Mapleton School District**

<b>Goal #1</b>	MHS will maintain the CTE program of study we started three years ago. Our CTE teacher will complete her certification in the next two years. Will focus on gender equity in all courses, including CTE and advanced/dual credit courses.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Students will earn credit in the course offerings in CTE. Juline Walker will continue working towards endorsement in CTE. (She is planning on working at a bank this summer through the Lane ESD supported program.)
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Students completing the three-course business sequence will be awarded a certificate of completion in business. 8 Students will earn this certificate. Business Classes have been taken by females at a much higher rate than their male counterparts. (2020-21- 0 male and 2 female students took the Business Mangement course. By 2025, our goal is to have it be 50% males-50%females.
<b>Goal #2</b>	MMS and MHS staff will be participating in professional development to learn how to support social and emotional learning with a focus on increasing student engagement.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Teachers, EA's and Administrators will be participating 6 PD sessions throughout each school year. These will be facilitated by Lane ESD staff. (This will take 3 hours per PD Friday.)
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Student attendance rates will go up. The attendance committee will set this goal in the fall of 2021.
<b>Goal #3</b>	Seniors at Mapleton High will take senior seminar. They will be given support for all graduation requirements and post-graduation planning, which will include scholarship applications, resume and job readiness skill building, military exploration, senior project support, community service support, and leadership training.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Seniors will receive CTE credit for senior seminar. Students will leave with a post-graduation plan.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	All graduating seniors will graduate with a post-graduation plan. Post graduating seniors will report that they were supported to their after high school life. (As evidenced by Lifetrack Surveys.)
<b>Goal #4</b>	Mapleton will offer Writing 115 and Writing 121 to qualifying juniors and seniors. There will be concerted efforts to make these courses accessible to all. There is a current disparity in the number of boys vs. girls taking the course, so an increase in gender equity will be a central focus.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Students will be encouraged to take advanced writing. Parents will be notified of the opportunity during fall registration.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	ELA College NOW Classes have been taken by females at a much higher rate than their male counterparts. (2020-21- 1 male and 5 female students took the Eng 104/106 courses) By 2025, out goal is to have it be 50-50.

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<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	Staff will participate in professional development for Social Emotional Learning. Daniel and Angela (from Lane ESD) will be working with staff during 6 PD Fridays with preK-12 Staff. Grant will pay for high school staff's time: 3 EA's and 9 teachers to participate in these opportunities.
<b>Goal(s) this activity addresses</b>	Goal 2
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #2</b>	Our PreK-12 counselor will work with students for academic success. They will guide students for academic, social and emotional support. They will lead a committee to improve attendance and communicate with families. (Salary for .5 counselor FTE)
<b>Goal(s) this activity addresses</b>	Goal 2 , Goal 3 , Goal 4
<b>College Level Opportunities Activity #1</b>	Juniors and seniors will be offered Writing 115 and 121 this year (2021-22). English 104 and 106 will be offered next year (2022-23).

<b>Career Technical Education Activity #1</b>	Juline Walker will continue to follow the required steps to become licensed in CTE. She is working closely with ESD staff for this licensure. 2021-2022- She will teach Intro to Business and Entrepreneurship. 2022-2023- She will teach Entrepreneurship and Business management
