Our target for the 2021-2022 school year is 31.81%, 2022-2023 is 34.81%, 2023-2024 37.81%, 2024-2025 40.81% and 2025-2026 43.8%.

Currently 4% of 9-12 grade students with disabilities at McLoughlin High School participated in accelerated learning in the 2019-2020 school year. By the 2024-2025 school year 25% of the students with disabilities will participate in accelerated learning opportunities. 4.2% annual growth rate over 5 years
Short-Term	To ensure a year over year growth of 7% starting the 2021-2022 school year
Outcome	the Student Success Coach (SSC) will go over the Emergent Bilingual students class schedules in August, December, and May of each school year to ensure Students with Disabilities have access to all accelerated classes. All staff will have a Department Pathway Poster displayed in their Classrooms to discuss it during Pioneer Time, end of the semester, and during forecasting. The Science department will have semester classes to provide more opportunities to different science contents. The AVID program will expand from 4th grade to 12th grade and will provide school wide AVID. To ensure a year over year growth of 4% starting the 2021-2022 school year the Student Success Coach (SSC) will go over the Students With Disabilities class schedules in August, December, and May of each school year to ensure Students with Disabilities have access to all accelerated classes.
