Goal #1	95% of our 9th grade students will have earned at least 6 credits by the end of their 9th grade year, which will have them on-track to graduation in 4 years.
Short-Term Outcome	9th grade data team members meet monthly to analyze 9th grade student data to determine the type of interventions/supports that are needed to ensure identified students are receiving the support necessary for their success in their courses. These interventions/supports are communicated to students parents and are monitored and adjusted based on student data.
Long-Term Outcome	The overall percentage of 9th grade students earning at least 6 credits will increase from 83% to 95% by the end of the 2024-2025 school year.
Goal #2	90% of JFK students will earn a minimum of 6 CTE credits prior to graduating.
Short-Term Outcome	8th grade students, with the help of their advisory teachers will choose a 4 year course plan that will focus on completion of at least 6 credits of CTE courses in Agriculture, Health Services, or Business and Finance.
Long-Term	At least 90% of JFK students will earn 6 CTE credits prior to graduating.

Dropout Prevention Activity #1	The hiring of a part time graduation coach who will focus on student attendance and credit completion, intentionally focusing on students who are historically underserved, students who are emerging bilingual, students with disabilities, and students experiencing poverty.

Career Technical Education Activity #1	8th grade students, along with their advisory teachers will create a 4 year course plan that includes earning at least 6 CTE credits prior to graduating. Students will use the 4 year course planning tool in the Naviance web-based curriculum.

Career Technical Education Activity #2	JFK will continue to employ a 1.0 FTE Agriculture teacher using HSS funding.

Career Technical Education Activity	JFK will focus on increasing enrollment in our health services program of study by reassigning one of our 1.0 FTE science teachers to a .5 FTE Health
#3	Services instructor and .5 FTE Science instructor.
