Goal #1	English Language Learner participation in Advanced Coursework, including CTE Pathway courses, will increase to 25% of the total ELL student population. This focus will also be for our other identified group "students with disabilities"
Short-Term	Teachers, College/Career Coordinator, Counselors and Family Outreach
Outcome	Advocate will actively encourage our identified focal students to pursue participation in CTE pathway Programs and other Advanced Coursework options in accordance with their post-secondary plans, as expressed in the student's education Plan and Profile.
Long-Term Outcome	ELL student enrollment in advanced coursework and career and technical courses will rise by 10% for each year of the biennium. Students with disabilities -student enrollment in advanced coursework and career and technical courses will rise to 40% by the end of the biennium.
Goal #2	86% of the ELL students will be on track to graduate after their ninth-grade year.
Short-Term Outcome	Ninth-grade Success Teams, including teachers, counselors, College/Career Coordinator and Family Outreach Advocate will meet bi-monthly to review data, evaluate the effectiveness of student supports and elicit frequent
	student and family input in creating student plans.
Long-Term Outcome	The overall 9th grade on-track rate of ELL students will increase by 10%.
Goal #3	The 4-year graduation rate for our identified focal students will increase to 85% by the end of the 2024-25 school year.
Short-Term Outcome	The Student Success Team will meet bi-monthly to review and track the following data for our focal students. Long-Term Outcome	4-year graduation rate of our focal group will increase by 85% by the end of the 2024-25 school year.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Family Outreach Coordinator will be an integral participant on Student Success Team to review weekly student attendance, grade and course selection data and reach out to support students and families who are struggling in these areas. This will include a focus on our English Language Learners.

Career Technical Education Activity #2	Welding provides an opportunity for students to earn a living wage as Certified Welders. With the construction of a new CTE Center in the high school, welding is being added to the curriculum for 2021/22. Additionally, the Culinary Arts Pathway is also supported by this grant. Students will also have the opportunity to participate in the Willamette Career Academy pathway program. This will provide a more diverse selection of CTE courses from which students can choose to participate.
