Goal #1	9th Grade on Track: We will reach 93% average for daily attendance with a targeted focus on students identified in our focal groups (addressing attendance issues at this level supports the engagement required for academic success for high school career)
Short-Term Outcome	We will continue to implement A2A (family outreach and engagement) with fidelity , conduct 9th grade Link Crew, 8th and 9th grade orientation, incentivize attendance, educate parents through the Wellness Center on attendance, staff will conduct home visits. Weekly attendance meeting with administrators, teachers, instructional coach, Migrant/Graduation Specialist, looking at data, with an emphasis on our identified focal groups.
Long-Term Outcome	Average Daily Attendance will increase by 5% across all demographics, with a focus on our identified focal groups.
Goal #2	GRADUATION RATE: OHS graduation rate increases to 95%.
Short-Term Outcome	Implementation of Career Fair, Job Fair and career-related field trips and CTE Fair/Tour/Awareness; Continued technology availability and integration for academics through Google Classroom, etc. on Chromebooks; Wellness Center support with mental/emotional support and awareness for parents and students; Transition program awareness; Junior year "family" conference for graduation planning; counselors meet with every student at least once throughout the year to review transcript. Grade review team will identify students off track at the end of each trimester. Staff is reviewing their F rates and changes to instructional practices. Students failing a class, will have the opportunity to retake the standards they failed, and have the opportunity to retake those to raise their grades. Summer school credit recovery (proficiency based, paid opportunities) Students are allowed to retake proficiencies.
Long-Term Outcome	OHS graduation rate increases by 6% with a focus on our identified focal groups.
Goal #3	Increase college and career participation by all students with a focus on our identified focal groups.
Short-Term Outcome	COLLEGE AND CAREER: Sophomores and Seniors complete aptitude testing that helps counselors guide their conversations with students for college and career opportunities; Implementation of Career Fair, Job Fair, College Fair and career-related field trips and CTE Fair/Tour/Awareness; Junior year "family" conference for graduation planning and next steps; Parent Education Night on how to guide and support student toward post-secondary choices. Multiple ELL/Migrant opportunities for families, parent night for those families giving them an opportunity to explore post-secondary options.
Long-Term Outcome	95% of students will have participated in at least one or more of the fairs/tours/field trips 95% of sophomores and seniors will have taken the aptitude test 40% of parents will have participated in Parent Education Night 40% of students in our identified focal groups will take one or more Advanced courses.
