<b>Lead Organization</b>	<b>Oregon Family School</b>
<b>Goal #1</b>	Goal: 75% of students will be on-track toward graduation after completing 9th grade.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Short-Term Outcome: Ninth grade success teams (teachers and relevant support staff) are meeting regularly, looking at data, student supports are tracked for effectiveness and students and families are involved in the evaluation of those supports.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Long-Term Outcome: The overall 9th grade on-track rate of students will increase by 10%.
<b>Goal #2</b>	Goal: Students will document and track post-secondary plans following graduation and will move along a deliberate path through school toward their preferred next steps in college or career.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Short-Term Outcome: Teachers actively encourage students who are members of groups of students not typically engaged in advanced coursework or career and technical courses to pursue these paths in accord with their post-secondary plans, as expressed in the student's education plan and profile.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Long-Term Outcome: Student enrollment in advanced coursework and career and technical courses will rise by 25% with the largest increases seen in focal student groups identified in the district needs assessment.
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	All 9th grade students and their parents will meet with advisors to develop an individualized learning plan at the beginning of the school year. Any reading struggles, such as Dyslexia, will be screened for and appropriate supports provided as needed.
<b>Goal(s) this activity addresses</b>	Goal 1
<b>College Level Opportunities Activity #1</b>	Beginning in 10th grade, students will be offered the opportunity to take a college success class at the local community college. Beginning in 11th grade, students will be offered concurrent enrollment at the local community college, up to 12 credits per term.
