Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Through our SST process we will identify students that are struggling and then provide tier 1 and 2 supports from teachers to address drop out indicators. We track every student, call home and support the student and family through our SST process This work will specifically target our identified focal students.

College Level Opportunities Activity #1	All 9th grade students will be introduced to our College Now courses and will be required to take a CTE Computer Science Dual Credit course through Lane Community College.

Career Technical Education Activity #1	All students are introduced to our CTE offerings in 8th grade and then required to take a CTE Computer Science course in their 9th grade year. Looking to reinstate this program, this is an 18 week course offered to 8th grad only. 1.0 FTE Ag. Teacher
