Goal #1	Given Technical Assistance, support for Emerging and Best Practices in absenteeism, the Port Orford Langlois SD will implement an EIIS in order to reduce chronic absenteeism and increase regular attendance"
Short-Term Outcome	Increase regular attendance by 5% in the 2021-22 and 2022-23 school years.
Long-Term Outcome	Pacific HS will have a 90% regular attendance rate by the 2024-25 school year.
Goal #2	Increase participation of focal group students by 20% in dual credit courses.
Short-Term Outcome	Increase percentage of focal groups participation in dual credit courses. The district is using SIA grant dollars to hire a K-12 Counselor who will support academics and encourage students to participate in our dual credit courses and eliminate barriers that could be discouraging students from enrolling in these courses.
Long-Term Outcome	Ensure that all focal groups have increased their level of participation by a minimum of 20% in our college level course offerings.
