<b>Goal #1</b>	Given Technical Assistance, support for Emerging and Best Practices in absenteeism, the Port Orford Langlois SD will implement an EIS in order to reduce chronic absenteeism and increase regular attendance"
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Increase regular attendance by 5% in the 2021-22 and 2022-23 school years.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Pacific HS will have a 90% regular attendance rate by the 2024-25 school year.
<b>Goal #2</b>	Increase participation of focal group students by 20% in dual credit courses.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Increase percentage of focal groups participation in dual credit courses. The district is using SIA grant dollars to hire a K-12 Counselor who will support academics and encourage students to participate in our dual credit courses and eliminate barriers that could be discouraging students from enrolling in these courses.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Ensure that all focal groups have increased their level of participation by a minimum of 20% in our college level course offerings.
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	We are creating a part-time attendance monitoring position for the district. This position will monitor student attendance and work with students and families to eliminate the barriers that are creating lack of attendance. 28
