Goal #1	90% of the high school students will have an interest of what they want to do leading up to and beyond graduation. Everyone will have a plan for post graduation.
Short-Term Outcome	Students will use the Youscience program to help facilitate their interests toward a career they desire. The Youscience program specifies as an aptitude analyzer and interest finder for students.
Long-Term Outcome	Graduation rates will remain at 95% or higher and all graduating seniors will have a plan on post graduation endeavors.
Goal #2	Absenteeism will be addressed through promotion of school spirit through extra curricular activities and development of programs that appeal to a variety of student interests such as CTE, art, physical conditioning and dual credit.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers actively encourage students who are members of groups of students not typically engaged in CTE, art, physical conditioning and dual credit. This will have an effect on graduation rates, absenteeism and 9th grade on track.
Long-Term Outcome	Student enrollment in CTE, art, physical conditioning and dual credit courses will rise by 25% with the largest increases seen in focal student groups identified in the district needs assessment.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	We will hire a counselor. The counselor will be in charge of attendance data and monitoring students on track to graduation.
Goal(s) this activity addresses	Goal 1 , Goal 2
Dropout Prevention Activity #2	Hire staff member to support students who need extra help in classes to ensure on-time graduation, including students with disabilities (grades 8-12) and we will actively encourage students who have not traditionally enrolled in advanced coursework or career paths to consider and test these options as appropriate to their post-high school plans described in the student's education plan and profile.
