<b>Lead Organization</b>	<b>Prospect School District</b>
<b>Goal #1</b>	Goal: Students will document and track post-secondary plans following graduation and will move along a deliberate path through school toward their preferred next steps in college or career. A middle school summer school program will support advanced coursework exposure.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Short-Term Outcome: Teachers and guidance counselor actively encourage students who are members of groups of students not typically engaged in advanced coursework or career and technical courses to pursue these paths in accord with their post-secondary plans, as expressed in the student's education plan and profile. A new staff position will support this outcome by supporting students and increasing advanced coursework exposure. Former students from focal groups will return to mentor/speak to students.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Long-Term Outcome: Student enrollment in advanced coursework and career and technical courses will rise by with 15% the largest increases seen in focal student groups identified in the district needs assessment.
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	Prospect will hire support staff to administer and facilitate alternative learning opportunities and counsel students that are struggling in attendance, grades, and HS planning benchmarks.

<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #2</b>	High school preparedness summer session for 8th grade students entering High school summer session for credit retrieval, remediation, and/ or acceleration for grades 9-12.

<b>College Level Opportunities Activity #1</b>	Prospect will support to support early high school planning, college visits, job fairs, internship opportunities to support college level inquiry and exploration.

<b>Career Technical Education Activity #1</b>	Upgrade CTE program facilities and equipment and hire .5 FTE CTE staff to improve and diversify instruction.
