Lead Organization	Santiam Canyon School District
Goal #1	90% of students experiencing poverty will be graduate on-time.
Short-Term Outcome	Administration, counselors, and various support staff will meet twice yearly to review students who have failed classes. The team will look at their achievement data and create and put in place supports to help this student successfully pass their classes.
Long-Term	The overall graduation rate of students who are living in poverty will be equal
Outcome	to our overall student graduation rate.
Goal #2	Students will have the opportunity to participate in three different CTE program.
Short-Term Outcome	We will have a full Program of Study running in the field of Hospitality and Tourism Management with a focus on Culinary.
Long-Term Outcome	All students will be a completer in 1 POS of their choice.
Goal #3	Our students will have the opportunity to earn college credit through the Willamette Promise program.
Short-Term Outcome	We will add Writing 121 and 122 through WP to our offerings.
Long-Term Outcome	75% of graduating seniors should have taken at least one college credit class while at Santiam.
College Level Opportunities Activity #1	We will pay Willamette Promise stipends to teachers who offer dual credit. This also includes the WP program fee.
