Lead Organization	Scio High School
Goal #1	Scio School district will increase the 4-year cohort graduation rate (currently 79%) by 5% at the end of June 2023. Students with disabilities and students who experience poverty will rise by 7% (currently 69%).
Short-Term Outcome	Scio High School will move advisory groups from once a week for 30 minutes to 30 minutes daily. Students will learn to read transcripts, what it takes to graduate, make post-secondary goals, create and reflect on a 4-year plan starting 9th-grade year. Students will stay in the same advisory group for 4 years with the same teacher. Mentor teachers will be trained by our AVID elective teachers and PD in SMART goal setting, Naviance, and post-secondary options. WillCA will continue weekly 30 min advisory sessions for 30 minutes and will include monthly advisory 9-11 sessions.
Long-Term Outcome	Scio School district's overall graduation rate will increase to 90% by 2025. Students will learn to read transcripts, what it takes to graduate, make post-secondary goals, create and reflect on a 4-year plan starting 9th-grade year. Advisory teachers will be trained in SMART goal setting, Naviance, and post-secondary options.
Goal #2	Scio School District will raise 9th grade on track by 7% by 2023.
Short-Term Outcome	Ninth-grade success teams (teachers and relevant support staff) will meet once a month to look at data, student supports will be tracked by a 9th-grade success coordinator. The coordinator will gather all data and track the effectiveness of interventions and will help plan meetings with students and families.
Long-Term Outcome	Scio school district will have a 90% of students will be on track toward graduation after completing 9th grade by 2023.
Goal #3	Students will document and track post-secondary plans following graduation and will move along a deliberate path through school toward their preferred next steps in college or career.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers actively encourage students who are members of groups of students not typically engaged in advanced coursework and/or career and technical courses to pursue these paths in accord with their post-secondary plans, as expressed in the student's education plan and profile. Our CTE teachers will work with regional partners to keep up on cutting-edge technology and make sure we are meeting the needs of the local industry. Students will have access to technology so they can pursue advanced coursework in today's modern world.
Long-Term Outcome	Student enrollment in advanced coursework and career and technical courses will rise by 25% with the largest increases seen in focal student groups identified in the district needs assessment by 2025.
