Lead Organization	Springfield School District
Goal #1	Student groups (females, students with disabilities, underrepresented populations, and emerging bilinguals) will participate in dual credit coursework (all types) at the same rate as their peers.
Short-Term Outcome	 All high schools will implement a Naviance scope and sequence with every student. Students will have fully developed, monitored and adjusted Education Plan and Profiles to support preparing to achieve their post-secondary goals. Community partnership with UO/Aspire will bolter student connections with near peers at UO and support college and career exploring activities in high school.
Long-Term Outcome	Collate and analyze district Naviance data from 2022-24 on student career interest surveys and review by race/ethnicity and our current offerings of CTE pathways to develop/align our offerings to match both student interests and industry needs.
Goal #2	All students will leave 9th and 10th grade on-track toward graduation.
Short-Term Outcome	Implement at least monthly meeting/teaming structures that identify students at risk of not ending the year on track to graduate, and utilizes teachers to intervene in a timely manner to support students. Continue Night School system of supports to intervene during the school year when students fail a course, rather than waiting a year or more to retake the
	course.
Long-Term	Student data show 10th and 11th-grade enrollment with increasing numbers
Outcome	of students on track for graduation.
Goal #3	Increase the district four-year cohort district graduation rate by 10%, closing the gap between underserved populations and all students, by June 2023.
Short-Term Outcome	AVID Implementation starts 2021-22 school year. Aligned Naviance scope and sequence delivered to all high school students in 2021-22 SY. Teaming structures that address all students, grades 9-12, begins 2021-22 SY. Equitable grading practices and enrollment opportunities for students (continue 2021-22 SY). Special Education model redesigned, expanding cotaught courses. UO/Aspire partnership fully developed to support summer learning in SPS, UO/Aspire week (July 2021) and ongoing near peer mentorship and experience during the school year.
Long-Term	Student data reflect equitable participation and performance across student
Outcome	groups and reflect the work that we have focussed on with our staff and community.
Goal #4	Chronic Absenteeism rates will improve to reflect at least 90% of SPS students as regular attenders.
Short-Term	Care and connect team structures to support student attendance, at each
Outcome	building, accessing Tier 3 supports (district team), as appropriate. Implement a SPS attendance campaign districtwide to communicate the importance of school attendance on graduation in four years.

Dropout Prevention Activity #1	1. Create student-centered forecasting and master scheduling process across all high schools. This includes our middle school and high school transition assistant salaries, who are working together to identify student interests and support forecasting for 9th grade to get students into the classes that are aligned to their interests, as indicated in their education plan and profile, hosting orientation and forecasting meetings with students and families, training staff (counselors, administrators) on building a master schedule that is student-oriented rather than staff directed.
