Goal #1	By the end of year three, 95% of 9th grade students will be on track toward graduation, and interventions will be in place for students not meeting this goal.
Short-Term Outcome	With building operation challenges, COVID did not permit staff to have a regular data teams. Thus, we plan to re-institute data teams within the building at each grade level. Ninth grade success teams (building administration/teachers/classified staff) will meet regularly, looking at data, student supports are tracked for effectiveness and students and families are involved in the evaluation of those supports.
Long-Term Outcome	Increase the capacity and enrollment of students in CTE programs that provide career-specific technical training in conjunction with industry partners. We would like to see a 20% increase in student participation.
Goal #2	Students will have a clear path identified and recorded for progress towards graduation, as well as their post-secondary plans for college and/or career, that is reviewed regularly.
