Organization Goal #1	Goal: 90% of students will be on-track toward graduation after completing 9th grade.
Short-Term Outcome	Short-Term Outcome: Freshman Success Team (Educational Facilitators [EF] and relevant support staff) meet monthly to review freshman at-risk early warning data with an emphasis on our identified focal groups, determine their specific student learning needs, build responsive, personalized interventions tracked and evaluated by students, parents, and team members for effectiveness.
Long-Term Outcome	Long-Term Outcome: The overall 9th grade on-track rate will increase by 10%.
Goal #2	Goal: 80% of students will graduate by year four or five (adjusting for transfers in and out).
Short-Term Outcome	Short-Term Outcome: Student engagement increases (as measured by student engagement survey and course completion and graduation data) by offering relevant programs and curricula (with an emphasis on our identified focal groups) as defined by their personal education plan and profile. Staff will specifically focus on our focal groups to ensure that they are creating a challenging and engaging plan that can and will move then towards graduation. Academic and Career Advisor/Student Success Team will meet with an emphasis on our identified focal groups to focus on grades, attendance, etc, creating interventions and individual support to keep them on track towards graduation. Staff will be paid stipends over the summer to create engaging curriculum
Long-Term Outcome	Long-Term Outcome: Graduation rate will increase by 30% especially in our identified focal groups.
Goal #3	Goal: 90% of graduating seniors complete a rigorous career pathway, earn a CTE certification or an Associates of Arts Oregon Transfer (AAOT).
Short-Term Outcome	Every teacher will work with students around their ILP and how to review and revise their goals. Individual counseling for our focal students to ensure that they are on track to complete a rigorous career pathway. Offer PD for staff that self identify educational gaps, allowing them to create a plan for courses they can take over the summer and courses they are developing in teams. Short-Term Outcome: Students in grades six through twelve develop and maintain a comprehensive, personalized Education Plan and Profile (EPP), which will serve as their 'road map' throughout school and prepare them for their post-secondary transition.
Long-Term Outcome	Long-Term Outcome: Graduating seniors who complete a rigorous career pathway, earn a CTE certification or, an Associates of Arts Oregon Transfer (AAOT) will increase by 5% annually.
