Lead Organization	Tigard-Tualatin School District
Goal #1	Increase in credit attainment for 9th graders. 100% of 9th grade students will be on-track toward graduation by June 2024.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers at our 2nd comprehensive high school will have common prep based on teacher teams where they will host student success meetings across all of 9th grade. All students will be placed in a heterogeneous house based on data.
Long-Term Outcome	Latinx, students in special education and ELD students will increase their on track rates by a minimum of 10%.
Goal #2	By June 2023, 100% of TTSD 9th graders will complete at least one college/career pathway course (CTE) by the end of 9th grade (expansion to 2nd high school).
Short-Term Outcome	The 9th grade CTE wheel will be implemented at Tigard High School by the 22-23 school year (paused due to COVID).
Long-Term Outcome	100% of students will take a minimum of 1 CTE course.
Goal #3	Increase the percentage of students taking college-level courses, specially communities that have been historically undeserved.
Short-Term Outcome	Through partnership with Equal Opportunity Schools we will have student survey feedback to inform how to increase enrollment for historically underserved communities.
Long-Term Outcome	Enrollment in IB will increase by 5% among our Black/African American, Latinx, Islander, Special Education and ELD communities.
Goal #4	Increase graduation rates for all students.
Short-Term Outcome	Improve academic outcomes and on track rates for 10-11th graders to be on track to graduate in four years.
Long-Term Outcome	Increase graduation rates for all students from 88% to 92%.
