<b>Lead Organization</b>	<b>Umatilla School District</b>
<b>Goal #1</b>	All students will leave 9th grade with information on their progress toward graduation and a plan for graduating.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Short-Term Outcome: Students will successfully complete Success 101 and develop their ten year plan by the end of their Freshman year.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Long-Term Outcome: Students who identify college/career plans that align to applicable college course offerings during high school will chart their course plan with the school counselor and monitor it twice/year to ensure progress is being made towards their goals.
<b>Goal #2</b>	100% of students will be engaged in an internship, mentoring opportunity, career exploration class or activity, or employment opportunity while in high school.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Short-Term Outcome: Students will enroll in at least one internship/mentoring/career exploration class during their high school experience.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Long-Term Outcome: Students will graduate with a fully completed college or career path identified and relevant work experience or coursework in hand.
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	A .5 FTE robotics and programming teacher at UHS is utilized to support the Amazon Web Services project where students receive mentorship, coursework and potential internships. A .5 teacher focusing on career development and goal setting is supported with this fund. A 1.0 daycare teacher and .75 assistant is supported with this fund. The teacher provides a class for a career pathway into childcare and the teacher and assistant also provide daycare to pregnant parenting students free of charge. A .75 FTE counseling secretary is supported with this fund. These positions are used to provide electives to keep students interested and connected to school, career pathway opportunities and direct student support (counseling and pregnant parenting services) to keep students connected to resources and in school.
<b>Goal(s) this activity addresses</b>	Goal 1 , Goal 2
<b>College Level Opportunities Activity #1</b>	We use these funds to support the tuition, fees, mileage costs and books for students who are enrolled in college courses through dual credit or online classes. We pay for classes that work towards a career certification, AAOT or OTM.
<b>Goal(s) this activity addresses</b>	Goal 2
<b>Career Technical Education Activity #1</b>	We pay for robotics team travel, materials and fees with this fund. We also use this fund to support equipment purchases for our CTE classes.
