Goal #1	90% of students will leave their 9th grade year on track to graduate.
Short-Term Outcome	The ninth grade core team which consists of teachers, support staff, and administration meet on a regular basis to review data to determine if students are making adequate progress in classes. Parents, guardians, and in some cases local authories are involved in determining effectivness of strategies employed.
Long-Term	The percentage of students on track to graduate at the end of the ninth grade year will increase by 5%.

Goal #2	Students who are deficient in credits needed toward graduation will be given opportunities throughout the school year and during the summer to make up lacking credit.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers and administration will make recommendations for credit recovery after semester grades have been posted. Students will be enrolled in credit recovery options either at the end of the first semester with the intention of credit recovered by the end of the second semester or be enrolled in summer school opportunities with the expectation credit will be recovered prior to the start of the new school year.
Long-Term	90% of students enrolled in credit recovery options will complete their credit
Outcome	recovery program successfully by the time frame determined.
Goal #3	Students in grades 8 - 12 will complete a five year plan of success. This plan will include a forecast of future courses throughout their high school years and may include an aptitude test that will increase the opportunity to achieve their desired post high school goals.
Short-Term Outcome	All students in grades 8 through 12 will complete the five year plan of success with the school counselor
Long-Term Outcome	Students gaining 2+2 credits or enrolled in dual credit opportunities will increase by 10% each year over the next year two years.
Goal #4	All students will be given additional opportunties to enroll in CTE course credits in areas of interest through enhanced online learning opportunties.
Short-Term Outcome	Students will be given opportunities to expand their knowledge of a CTE area through an online opportunity either taught by one of our instructors or by the online program instructors.
Long-Term Outcome	The percentage of students who enroll in additional CTE online opportunties will increase by 10% each year over the next two years.
