Goal #1	85% of 9th grade students will be on-track.
Short-Term Outcome	9th Grade On Track team (staff) will meet regularly to look at data and come up with support plans for students. Students and families will help evaluate the effectiveness of the supports. All freshman will take Freshman Focus for one period during 9th grade. The course will help students build foundational academic and social/emotional skills for success.
Long-Term	The overall 9th Grade On Track will increase by 10%

Goal #2	Students taking CTE courses will increase by 10%.
Short-Term	Will expand CTE courses to expose students to new career fields and allow
Outcome	them to explore interests. This will help guide us in the expansion of our future CTE programs of study.
Long-Term	CTE courses, programs of study, and opportunities will expand and diversify
Outcome	to promote more career pathways for students.
Goal #3	Attendance will improve by 10%
Short-Term Outcome	To reduce chronic absenteeism and reinforce dropout prevention, we will create a tiered system of support and intervention. The attendance team will use data to identify areas of growth and provide school wide positive reinforcement. In addition, the attendance team will meet weekly to analyze data and implement levels of support based on need.
Long-Term	Attendance will improve by 15% with the largest increase seen in the focal
Outcome	groups identified in the needs assessment.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	The 9th Grade on Track team will meet monthly to review student progress. We will focus on students who are not making adequate academic progress. Interventions will be created to support students. We will also plan and coordinate activities that will be proactive for 9th graders to transition into high school and maintain the level of support needed to feel a sense of value and belonging. We will use funds to pay a portion of the salary for a teacher to teach a Freshman Focus course to all 9th graders. This will provide support and skills to help them be successful academically and socially.

Dropout Prevention Activity #2	Our attendance coordinator will work collaboratively with the attendance secretary to obtain accurate attendance data weekly. The coordinator will analyze data and place students into the appropriate tier for support (level 1, 2, 3). The attendance team will meet weekly to discuss students who are needing level 2 and 3 supports, which may include letters, meetings, attendance contracts and citations. A portion of the budget will be used to pay part of the salary for our attendance coordinator.
