

GLOBAL SCORES

All teachers involved in the pilot will be using the same global scores. This will provide a common language among staff, students, and parents.

INC means the assignment is Incomplete

EXC means the assignment was excused for that student

ATI means that the assignment has been already turned in but not yet graded

COM means that the assignment was done on time

NOD means that the assignment has yet to be completed

FIX means that the assignment needs to be fixed/redone/completed

***COM** means that the assignment is now complete, just was not done on the due date

ABS means that the child was absent either the day it was assigned or the day it was due

BEG Beginning level entered for a 55%, the traditional F grade

APP Approaching level entered for a 65%, student is closer to passing but not quite there yet

MTS Meets level entered for a 75%, student is proficient, the traditional C grade

ADV Advanced level entered for an 85%, the traditional B grade

MAS Mastery level entered for a 95%, the traditional A grade
