Oregon Administrative Rule 581-022-2445 requires school districts to universally screen all students for risk factors of dyslexia in kindergarten, and in first grade for students who are new to Oregon public school in first grade, using a screening test that is on the Department's approved list referenced in OAR 581-002-1820 and administering the measures in each area in 581-002-1820(2)(b) with fidelity as per guidelines of the test developers. The following pages include a detailed one-pager for each of the approved screening tools listed above. Each one-pager includes the test administration guidelines for the screening tool, names the vendor/publisher-specific subtests used to measure each of the required areas in kindergarten and first grade and indicates the time of year that the subtests are administered according to test developer guidelines.
