

## Transition Resource Booklet: 2013-2014

The 2013 booklet presents materials to help educators prepare secondary transition students for success. The book is divided into sections of particular interest to administrators, case managers and teachers, those working with other agency service providers, and those working with students and families. While each of these sections could stand alone, there is value in reviewing all sections as responsibilities will overlap, and the sections cover a range of materials.

The **ADMINISTRATORS** section contains information such as legal and reporting requirements, general information and compliance issues. This section is most appropriate for special education administrators, principals, and other school district administrators.

The **CASE MANAGERS and TEACHERS** section contains information such as effective practices, compliance with the eight transition components, transition planning, and resources. This section is most appropriate for case managers, IEP coordinators, and special education teachers.

The **AGENCY PARTNERS** section provides materials for an IEP team as they develop plans to work with other agency partners involved with successfully transitioning students to adult life. Teachers may want to share this material with families, Vocational Rehabilitation counselors, community college disability services, case managers, and others as a starting point for discussions.

The **STUDENT and FAMILIES** section supports working together to support the child's independence through the effective use of transition components. This section is most appropriate for case managers, teachers, administrators or school personnel when working with students, parents, guardians, and foster parents.

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
