

Outcome Statement

Each Competency Area begins with an Outcome statement. For example, the Competency Area on Typical/Atypical Child Development begins with the Outcome:

OUTCOME
EI/ECSE personnel will demonstrate knowledge across developmental domains of typical child development, the characteristics of delayed development, and the patterns of atypical development associated with disabilities.

Outcome statements are followed by a series of boxes that contain the specific competencies related to the respective Competency Area (See example below). The boxes are comprised of two rows. The first row contains the specific competency to be addressed. The second row contains two series of numbers that represent the mastery and documentation requirements for the specific competency.
