- SICC has participated in assisting The Alliance for Early Intervention
- Dana Hepper is leading the effort in support
- Many members of SICC are now participating in supporting this group
- Proposed budget and General fund for EI/ECSE is 20,000 less than less biennium, another reduction in the SSA funding, 3 million dollars less
 - O Total reduction is 17 million dollars for EI/ECSE
 - ESSR Funding is sunsetting, we knew this was covid relief and would be ending
- Number served went down during COVID, numbers have been rising back up and in some areas have surpassed pre covid numbers
- Struggling to keep staff- Close to fully staffed, this will be a crisis for EI/ECSE, inclusion and adequate service levels
