Implementation Calendar

Assumptions: Case counts continue to decrease. As of 1/25/2021 we have 218 cases per 100,000 which is down from the previous two week span which was 299 cases per 100,000

February 16 Pre School (Maybe Seniors & Juniors)

February 22 Add K-3

March 1 Add 4-8

March 8 Add 9-12 (if Seniors and Juniors have not already started)

Students will attend in two Cohorts –

Cohort A will attend on Monday & Tuesday

Cohort B will attend on Thursday & Friday

On Campus Meals

Cohort A – Food for Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday

Cohort B – Food for Thursday, Friday, Sunday

Meal Plan

Assumptions:

- All students on campus eat and take all meals.
- Students have two weeks to change between hybrid learning and CDL learning. Secretaries will update a shared file if students transfer from one program to another.

Process for Students on Campus :

- All students will eat lunch in their classroom, therefore these meals will be considered non-congregate meals.
 - Graded 3-12 will pick up in cafeteria and take back to the classroom for consumption
 - All components will be bundled except milk. Students can decline milk under OVS.
 - All students will come through the lunch line with their teacher, so there is no opportunity for a student to get two meals.

Key: B – Breakfast, L-Lunch

- We will use a clicker to count the number of students that get a lunch in the cafeteria before going back to class.
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- Preschool through 2nd grade meals will be delivered to classrooms and consumed.
 - All components will be prepackaged and students will receive all items with the exception of being able to decline milk. Students will order milk in the morning, so we know how many white and chocolate milks to provide.
 - Teachers will give each student one of each component. A menu will be included with the box, so teachers are aware of what to serve to students. Students may decline milk.
 - Teachers will mark students in mPower to help count our students each day.
- There is water in all elementary classrooms and water bottle refill stations throughout campus for all grades.
- Students will take home the following meals:
 - Cohort A attend school on Monday and Tuesday
 - Monday take home breakfast for Tuesday
 - Tuesday take home breakfast for Wednesday & Monday and lunch for Wednesday (See Meal Distribution Plan on file.)
 - Cohort B attend school on Thursday and Friday
 - Thursday take home breakfast for Friday
 - Friday take home breakfast for Sunday and Thursday and lunch for Sunday (See Meal Distribution Plan on file.)

Plan for Friday before students return: This transition will happen for Preschool students 2/13/2021. All other students either February 19th or K-3 on February 19th and all other students on February 26th

We will need to transition our intended consumption days and delivery days.

Cohort A students on current bus routes will get:

Sunday Breakfast and Lunch and Monday Breakfast (2B, 1L)

Cohort B students on current bus routes will get:

Breakfast for Sunday – Thursday (5B)

Lunch for Sunday – Wednesday (4L)

CDL students and community member on current bus routes will get:

Breakfast Sunday – Wednesday (4B)

Lunch Sunday – Wednesday (4L)

Old Intended Consumption

Key: B – Breakfast, L-Lunch

Wednesday Delivery (B & L W, Th, F)

Friday Delivery (B&L S, M, T)

New Intended Consumption with only one delivery day.

Cohort A (B & L - Th, F, S) (3B 3L)

Cohort B (B & L - M, T, W) (3B 3L)

CDL & Community (B & L – Th, F, S, M, T, W) (6B, 6L)

Integrity Plan

- Assumption all students on campus eat while they are on campus.
- Bus Routes will list all students we deliver to and will include grade, cohort, CDL, and community (x in Cohort column)
- If a student is in a cohort, we will highlight their name on the spreadsheet by route. (see attached sample page for a route.) Highlighted students will get a bag for 3 days of meals per the above intended consumption plan. Unhighlighted students will get a bag for 6 days of meals per the above intended consumption plan. (We may switch which group is highlighted and which group is not highlighted.)
- Since grades are included on this spreadsheet as we transition to hybrid, we will be able to highlight based on grade and update each week until all grades are on campus. (I am being extremely optimistic that our counts will continue to decline over the next few weeks.) We can also unhighlight as needed based on our case rates.
- Since the assumption is made that students who are on campus will receive a meal when they are here they will get a bag for 3 days of meals and CDL students and community will get 6 days of meals.
- Since our cohorts are set-up by grades, we will be able to change the highlighting if a grade is required to quarantine and do CDL.
- Delivery time on Wednesday would be from 7:00-3:30, so if the bus delivery time does not work for a family, we can set up an appointment for them to pick up their meals. This does not happen very often, but we do get the occasional call with this requesting.

Currently In CNP Web

Serving-Wednesday and Friday-3 lunches and 3 breakfasts are served on 6 bus routes between 10:55-1:30. Four buses stays at their last stop for up to 15 minutes. They are scheduled to be at these stops from 1:00-1:15. On the Rainier Campus at the airlock, we will serve meals to the public from 12:45-1:15.

Serving-Wednesday and Friday-3 lunches and 3 breakfasts for staff whose children are learning at home with pick up in commons between 7:15-3:30. This allows parents to pick up meals before work or at the end of the day. Also, we can set-up appointments for families that are not able to pick up meals during the typical bus route times.

Key: B – Breakfast, L-Lunch

Daily grab and go meals are served on site for children whose parents are working on campus. The meals are picked up and taken back to the classroom for consumption. We serve breakfast from 7:15-8:00 and lunch from 11:30-1:00. Friday families that eat on campus will receive a breakfast and lunch for consumption on Sunday.

Potential Changes to CNP Web when we move to hybrid.

- Serving – Wednesday Hybrid Students in Cohorts will get 3 lunches and 3 breakfasts, CDL and Community will get 6 lunches and 6 breakfast. We will run 6 bus routes between 9:30-11:30. On the Rainier Campus at the airlock, we will serve meals to the public from 11:30-11:45.
- Serving-Wednesday -3 lunches and 3 breakfasts for staff whose children are in hybrid learning and 6 lunches and 6 breakfast for those in CDL. Pick up in commons between 7:15-3:30. This allows parents to pick up meals before work or at the end of the day. Also, we can set-up appointments for families that are not able to pick up meals during the typical bus route times.
- Daily grab and go meals for all students on campus following the district Hybrid Learning Meal Plan on file with ODE.
- If we provide child care, these students will be recorded for the time they are on campus and will take home meals when they are not on campus.
