



# MEAL SERVICE MODELS WAIVER MATRIX

ODE is aware that school districts are considering several meal service models and schedule types for SY 2020-2021. Some of the most common options are listed below with waivers that could apply to the corresponding meal service models. WAIVER TYPE	WAIVER SUMMARY
 <p data-bbox="40 808 560 861"><b>Offer Versus Serve</b></p>	<p data-bbox="560 651 1575 861">Waives the requirement for senior high schools to participate in Offer Versus Serve during school year 2020-2021, thus allowing high schools to serve pre-plated meals in non-congregate or classroom settings.</p>
 <p data-bbox="40 1029 560 1081"><b>Alternative Meals Time</b></p>	<p data-bbox="560 871 1575 1081">Waives required NSLP meal service times to allow school operators more flexibility when planning various methods of non-congregate meal service.</p>
 <p data-bbox="40 1249 560 1302"><b>Meal Pattern</b></p>	<p data-bbox="560 1092 1575 1302">Allows operators experiencing supply issues to request a meal pattern waiver for the affected procurement/delivery cycle. ODE approves each request on a case-by-case basis.</p>
 <p data-bbox="40 1470 560 1522"><b>Parent Pick-Up</b></p>	<p data-bbox="560 1312 1575 1522">Allows parents/guardians to pick up meals without children/adult participants present when providing sufficient proof of guardianship.</p>
 <p data-bbox="40 1711 560 1764"><b>Non-Congregate</b></p>	<p data-bbox="560 1533 1575 1764">Waives the requirement that children be served in a congregate setting. Meals can be served via grab-and-go or home delivery to better facilitate physical distancing.</p>

# MEAL SERVICE MODELS

## Social Distant Cafeteria

Meals are served to students in the cafeteria with additional safety, distancing, and sanitation practices implemented.

## Meals in the Classroom

Meals are served to students in the classroom.

## Mobile Cafeterias

Meals are served on mobile food carts located throughout a school's campus.

## Offsite Meals

Students that elect to continue distance learning are provided meals through delivery or a grab-and-go model.

## SCHEDULE TYPE

### In-Classroom Learning

Students attend school onsite each day.

### Distance Learning

Students attend school offsite each day.

### A/B Schedule

Students rotate between in-classroom learning and distance learning.

## NON-CONGREGATE MEAL SERVICE WAIVER

### Meal Service Model:

Offsite Meals

### Possible Waiver Application:

Utilized in conjunction with the Alternative Mealtime Waiver, districts can:

- Send breakfast home with students at the end of each day.
- Provide multiple meals
- Setup an offsite pick-up location for grab & go meals
- Districts can offer meals via household delivery

### Schedule Type:

Distance Learning  
A/B Schedule

## ALTERNATIVE MEALTIME WAIVER

### Meal Service Model:

Offsite Meals, Mobile Cafeterias, Socially Distant Cafeterias, Meals in Classrooms

### Possible Waiver Application:

Districts can offer longer meal service times in the cafeteria to promote social distancing.

Districts can offer separate meal service times for distance learning students. *See above*

### Schedule Type:

Distance Learning  
A/B Schedule  
In-Classroom Learning

## PARENT MEAL PICK UP WAIVER

### Meal Service Model:

Offsite Meals

### Possible Waiver Application:

Parents can bring their child's scannable ID badge for quick, contactless pick up of meals.

### Schedule Type:

Distance Learning  
A/B Schedule

## MEAL PATTERN WAIVER

### Meal Service Model:

Offsite Meals, Mobile Cafeterias, Socially Distant Cafeterias, Meals in Classrooms

### Possible Waiver Application:

Districts can request this waiver if they are having a hard time procuring a specific milk type or a sub-group for the vegetable component.

Distance Learning  
A/B Schedule  
In-Classroom Learning

## OFFER VERSUS SERVE MEAL SERVICE WAIVER

### Meal Service Model:

Offsite Meals, Mobile Cafeterias, Socially Distant Cafeterias, Meals in Classrooms

### Possible Waiver Application:

Districts can offer pre-plated meals in the classroom instead of a communal cafeteria.

Districts can offer pre-plated meals for grab and go meals.

### Schedule Type:

Distance Learning  
A/B Schedule  
In-Classroom Learning
