The Advisory Group will review and discuss strategies identified in HB2016 and begin the process of making recommendations to the Department of Education on addressing the academic needs of African American/Black Students.

This meeting will focus on the development of a charter for the group and on past and recent academic data pertaining to African American/Black students.
