

Needs Index


- The needs index is the unweighted combination of the following eight demographic variables:
 - Percent of students who are current or former English learners.
 - Percent of current and former English learners who are economically disadvantaged.
 - Percent of current and former English learners who are homeless.
 - Percent of current and former English learners who are migrant.
 - Percent of current and former English learners who are recent arriver.
 - Percent of current and former English learners who are mobile.
 - Unique count of home languages spoken by current English learners.
 - District small area income and poverty estimate (SAIPE).
- The scale of the index is 0 to 100.
 - 0 is low need.
 - 100 is high need.

Outcomes Index

- The outcomes index is the weighted combination of the following four outcomes:
 - English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) growth for current English learners in grades 1-12.
 - Weight = 0.45
 - Five-year adjusted cohort graduation rate for current and former English learners.
 - Weight = 0.35
 - Smarter Balanced Mathematics growth for current and former English learners in grades 6-8¹.
 - Weight = 0.15
 - Post-secondary enrollment for current and former English learners.
 - Weight = 0.05
- The scale of the index is 0 to 100.
 - 0 is low outcome or performance.
 - 100 is high outcome or performance.

¹ Excludes current English learners whose (a) 'LEP' start date occurred on or after July 1, 2013 or (b) current ELPA performance level is '1' or '2' and did not use the stacked Spanish/English stimulus and item translations on the Smarter Balanced mathematics assessment.
