- → Learn from affirming curricula, books, and teachers.

## As an LGBTQ2SIA+ student, you are able to...

- → Participate in **sports**, **P.E.**, **and school activities** according to your gender.
- → Date who you want, if you want.
- → Form a **student group** like a GSA.
- → Seek gender-affirming, mental health, & reproductive health info and services.
