NOVEMBER/DECEMBER

- IPC Bylaws must be established for new sites.
- EASIE PART I Closes, 2nd week of month
- Engage in Tribal Consultation or Meaningful and Ongoing Collaboration
- Hold a Public Hearing

MARCH

- Send Final EASIE Part II Application to OIE prior to sending to US DOE
- EASIE PART II Submission Deadline, May 10 **Past Due**

MAY

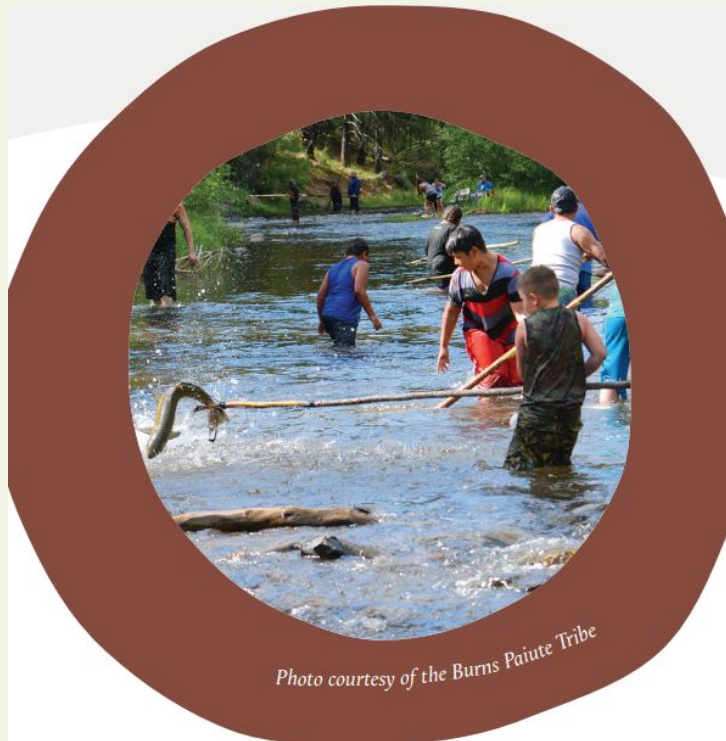

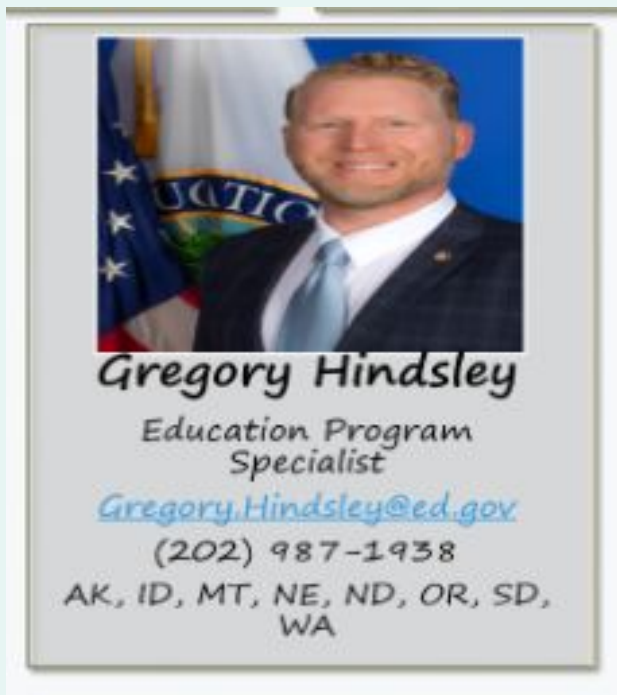
