


Grand Ronde Termination

- 3. Explain three effects of the Termination Act on Grand Ronde people.
- 4. Describe a time in the termination process when Native Tribes should have been consulted about the termination bill. How could this have changed the outcome of termination?
- 5. What was lost when the Grand Ronde Reservation closed in 1956?
- 6. Do you believe another termination bill would pass through Congress today? Why or why not?
