

SB 111 (Medicaid Pilot) Implementation



Parents and Student

Elects to sign consent required for district to bill Medicaid. Annual notice required for subsequent years



Local Education Agency (LEA)

- LEA is responsible to provide Free and Appropriate Education (FAPE) to all students.
- Child Find. LEA identifies students who qualify for IDEA. An individual Education Plan (IEP) is developed for each IDEA qualified student. IEP identifies health services required access to education.
- Health services (nursing, PT, SLP, transportation. . .) are provided as outlined in IEP regardless of Medicaid eligibility.
- Medicaid eligibility. LEA checks if student is eligible for Medicaid.
- Submits Medicaid billing via ORMED.

Center for Medicaid Services (Federal Medicaid Agency)

OHA (State Medicaid Agency)

- Manages Direct Service Billing and Medicaid Administrative Claiming (MAC billing)
- Manages Oregon State Medicaid Plan. State Plan details which services are billable.
- Approves cost calculations based on previous year's costs.
- Receives and disburses federal Medicaid share to districts once local match is paid.
- Provides oversight to LEAs who are billing Medicaid. Facilitates reviews and audits required by the Center for Medicaid Services.

Oregon Department of Education

- Oversight for state IDEA programs, data, and audits.
- Lead agency for implementation of SB 111 (Medicaid Pilot)
- Provides TA to districts to improve State Medicaid in Education billing.

3 School District responds to RA and submits match (\$30)

2 OHA issues remittance Advice (RA) to School District. RA details required match (\$30).

District submits match (\$30) to OHA and is reimbursed total cost (\$100)

1 School district submits Medicaid billing through ORMED to OHA.. (\$100)

Multnomah ESD's ORMED

- ORMED is a electronic billing provider.
- Validates across student IEP, Medicaid eligibility, provider recommendations, service logs, and signed parent consent.
- ORMED electronically submits Medicaid billing on behalf of LEA
- Allows documentation by service providers (nurses, OT, PT, SLP)

*Example: Health services in the amount of \$100 provided to a Medicaid/IDEA eligible student. Example assumes 30% match rate.
