Description of Project: The purpose of the project is to provide crushed rock for either rocking or maintaining haul routes associated with FY 27 timber sales such as Beyer Point, Second Course and Three Forks. In addition, it will provide crushed rock for FY 26 timber sales not yet sold but planned for in the last quarter, such as Phipps Creek and Wolfs Paw. The plan is to crush approximately 12,000 cubic yards of 2” – 0” rock out of the South Fork Jordan Pit and stockpile it at the 1.5 mile post on Jordan Creek Road.


