

<u>SPECIAL FOREST PRODUCTS FOR COMMERCIAL USE</u> <u>PERMIT REQUIRED</u>

A permit is required for collecting the following products and amounts from state forestland in the Astoria, Tillamook, Forest Grove, North Cascade, or West Oregon Districts.

Obtain permits at your local ODF office.
