



**SPECIAL FOREST PRODUCTS FOR PERSONAL USE NO PERMIT
REQUIRED - EXCEPT FOR FIREWOOD**

No permit is required for collecting the following products and amounts for personal use from state forestland in the Astoria, Tillamook, Forest Grove, North Cascade, or West Oregon Districts.

Amounts of materials may be in possession per vehicle at any one time.
For commercial use, or for greater amounts or different products, permits are required.
See your local ODF office for obtaining permits.

Boughs, Ferns (sword fern, bracken fern, and fiddleheads), Huckleberry, Manzanita, Moss, Oregon Grape, Salal, Vine maple, Other foliage and shrubs	12 Cubic Feet (ft ³) For greater volumes contact your local district office	16 grocery bags Or Depth of 6" inches in a standard 6' X 4' pickup bed.
Edible Fungi - e.g., mushrooms	1 Gallon or less Free permits up to 5 gallons see local District office.	One gallon or less per vehicle Free permits up to 5 gallons see local District office.
Edible Fungi - truffles	1 gallon or less	One gallon or less per vehicle
Campfire Wood	27 ft ³ (3 feet long, 3 feet wide, and 3 feet high)	Can only be used on the forest while camping on the forest.

PERMITS REQUIRED FOR FIREWOOD - \$20		
Personal use firewood	2 cords	A standard pickup bed is 1/2 cord. Firewood purchased using this method is for personal use only and is NOT to be sold commercially.
State-listed threatened and endangered plant species prohibited to collect. "Not Allowed"		

* Collection of Nelson's checkermallow, Kincaid's lupine, and other state-listed threatened and endangered plant species is prohibited by the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ORS 564, OAR 603-073). No plants or plant parts of any Oregon threatened and endangered species may be harvested or collected on state-managed forestlands. ** Collection and transport of any state-listed noxious weed is prohibited the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ORS 569, OAR 603-052). No noxious weed plants or plant parts may be harvested or collected on state-managed forestlands.
