Oregon Department of Forestry - 2022 Report on Agency Rulemaking for Chapter 629 (HB 4106)

House Bill 4106 (2016) requires state agencies to report annually to the Legislative Assembly on their rulemaking actions, both permanent and temporary.

In 2022, the Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) processed seven permanent rulemaking filings that adopted, amended, or repealed a total of 135 administrative rules. Table 1 provides additional detail on those rulemaking processes, actions taken, and rule numbers filed. The Department did not promulgate temporary rules in 2022 (Table 2).

81st Legislative Session enrolled Senate Bills 1501 and 1502, requiring the department to complete a consolidated rulemaking process under a single rule package to achieve several rule actions consistent with the requirements of the Private Forest Accord Report, published February 7, 2022, and to adhere to the legislatively prescribed effective dates.

Under the single rule package, 109 administrative rules were noticed as an adoption, amendment, or repeal due to the presiding statutes established with the enrollment of Senate bills 1501 and 1502. The department filed these rules based on their effective dates, within three permanent administrative orders: DOF 4-2022, DOF 5-2022, and DOF 7-2022.
