Agenda item: 1. Call to Order, Roll Call, Public comment & Approval of Agenda & Summary notes, updates & what's ahead **Presenter:** Terry Frueh

Summary: Roll call. House Keeping overview. No Public Comment. January Summary notes approved from committee.

Update: AMP Budget Update: the legislature did not make any budget cuts to the Program. Seth Barnes provided a brief update on recent discussions with the board. The conversation went well, and the board continues to expand its understanding of the AMP committee and its role.

Agenda Item: IRST Update (Presenter: Jesse Laney): The IRST provided an overview of updates to their literature review and responses to Amphibian Questions 1 and 2. Questions were addressed regarding progress and their approach to the scoping proposals.

Jesse Laney presented several options for Amphibians questions 1 & 2, noting that additional options are included in the proposal document:

Q1-A1 Option 1: Target sampling to refine species range limits.

Q1-A1 Option 2 (No Action Alternative): Use existing distribution data.

Q2-A1 Option 1: Establish a new long-term monitoring network.

Q2-A1 Option 2: Expand monitoring using existing datasets.

Summary: Timeline & IRST Clarifications (Presenters: Stacy Detwiler and Terry Frueh): An overview of the 2025–2026 timeline was provided. The presenters also discussed two clarifying questions from the IRST related to Question 3:

Clarification of focus (habitat vs. species): Proposed to address through group discussion during the meeting, followed by a work group to develop final text and/or provide direction to ODF staff.

Action Items:

1. AMPC requested Terry draft some language for question 3.1 to include species responses to rules, and connect new BGOs with existing questions.

2. Clarification of applicable rules: Proposed to address by requesting technical recommendations from ODF and consulting with IRST to narrow the list. This narrowed list will go to an AMPC workgroup (Seth Barnes, Amanda Sullivan-Astor, Wendy Gerlach, and Julie Firman), then to the full AMPC committee for final approval.
