

Monitoring Unit goals

Private Forests Division Monitoring

- **Determine if rules, voluntary measures:**
 - **Implemented appropriately**
 - **Effective in meeting resource protection goals**
- **Address highest priority monitoring questions for Division**
- **Work collaboratively with technical experts & stakeholders to produce high quality, transparent monitoring results**
- **Provide these results to Board & Stakeholders**

Monitoring Unit goals (cont.)

Coordinate and Collaborate

- **Coordinate with other monitoring efforts for efficient use of state resources, and integrated, state-wide monitoring**
- **Provide technical advice & support to other agencies engaged in monitoring**


Monitoring Strategy: Board direction

- Prioritized list of high-quality monitoring questions
- Inclusive, transparent process for developing Strategy
- Strategy integrated with enterprise monitoring (State Agencies)
- Spatial component to prioritization
