



# Current Fire Activity - Acres Burned As of 12/06/2016




# ODF Large Fire Costs YTD with 10 Yr Average

# 2016 Eboard General Fund Request Financials:



- Received \$1.7M Special Purpose Appropriation (SPA) for Severity Resources
- Deferred to early-session rebalance bill
  - \$6.7M for State's share of large fire costs
  - \$667,136 Treasury loan interest
  - \$532,278 Fire season 2017 district deductibles
  - \$111,813 Severity resources in excess of remaining SPA
- Deferred to Close of Session
  - \$2.6M base budget shortfall
