

Narrative:

our first fire was a hay stack ignited by a transformer blowing up above it. We had the help of Baker Rural. We managed to contain the fire to a single stack out of several in the stack yard. Eventually an irrigation pump and sprinkler system was set up to maintain control while it burned out and cooled off.

The remaining four fires all occurred on one Sunday in late August when dry lightning was forecast. We were blessed to receive a lot of rain with the lightning. This allowed us to fight fire with high humidity and damp fuels. If the rain had not come, we would have had dozens or possibly hundreds of fires from the hundreds or thousands of lightning hits. We were also blessed to have BLM crews that had been prepositioned due to the forecast.

the hole in the wall was fought by our crews with some assistance from BLM. Across the road and the river was a small fire, believed to be mostly on BLM land. It was very difficult access. The BLM helitack crew handled this fire by bucketing water out of the river with the helicopter.

A small fire was discovered after it had been put out by the rain in this area. Later in the afternoon, on Little Lookout Mountain, a lightning hit dried out enough to light off. This fire was fought with two land owner cats, the same helitack crew mentioned above, and about 16 LGRPA members. It was contained before dark, and mopped up over the next couple of days. Without the rain and without the BLM crews, I believe this lightning storm would have totally overwhelmed our resources. The next few days were dryer and windier, so the rapid initial attack by both LGRPA and BLM was critical to successfully stopping these fires while they were still small.

In addition to the hours of admin and training listed above for matching funds, The Phillips ranch took their truck tractor and brought the low boy trailer from Hermiston. This was a donation in kind of at least \$1200.00. In addition, Dick Fleming is constructing two pump stations with wells and 10,000 gallons of storage that will be available to the LGRPA for fire fighting. Expenditures of personal funds last year was approximately \$20,000, in addition to some grant funds. This could be considered an in kind donation.

Significant activities and projects

The fleet upgrade (mentioned on our 2016 report—the M1078 and the 998) continued this past summer with the addition of a 5 ton 6x6 with 1,000 gallons of water carrying capacity. This unit significantly enhances our fire fighting capability.

Also mentioned in our 2016 report was the agreement with Wheeler County Fire and Rescue to provide maintenance and logistical support to Twickenham RFPA. This has proven to be very beneficial for our department. WCFR was instrumental in getting the M1078, the Humvee and the 5 ton 6x6 set up for firefighting—water tanks, pumps, hose reels, radios, etc. These were significant projects and were done in a timely and efficient manner. It would have been very difficult to accomplish without their taking the lead on these improvements.

The OWEB grant (\$7,000) was also very beneficial for the Twickenham RFPA. Acquired to date has been additional PPE for our volunteers. This includes shirts, pants, helmets, headlamps and first aid kits. Also purchased were backpack pumps, packs and radio pouches. We were also able to acquire additional radios. With our remaining grant funds (approx.. \$4,000) we will be purchasing fire

shelters for all volunteers in time for the upcoming fire season. All the foregoing items are important for the safety and efficiency of our volunteers on the fireline,

The controlled burn on the Sixshooter Ranch planned for October, 2016 has been rescheduled for this year. Inclement weather and other priorities prevented it from happening last year.

Fire Suppression Activities

Again, the 2016 fire season was quiet in our protection area. We did respond to a haystack fire at the Cherry Creek Ranch but we were able to control it quickly and prevent it from spreading. We had two volunteers and one vehicle on scene with volunteer time amounting to 8 hours and truck time amounting to 4 hours.

Administrative matters continue to occupy a significant piece of volunteer time—billing membership dues, grant writing, report preparation, meetings, interface with the BLM and ODF and the Wheeler County Defense Board, vehicle maintenance, financial control and correspondence. At least 100 hours went toward these efforts in 2016.


