### Definition of Wildland-Urban Interface Requirement Review

- Significantly amends Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 477.015 to 477.064.
- Directs the Board of Forestry to establish a definition of Wildland-Urban Interface (WUI).
  - The WUI definition must be adopted by rule within 100 days of the effective date of the bill.

Additionally, the rules must <u>establish criteria</u> to identify and classify the WUI.



## Public comment summary

- <u>September 22, 2021, 2:00 p.m.</u> 12 members of the public attended the public hearing with no oral comments provided.
- <u>September 23, 2021, 7:00 p.m.</u> 9 members of the public attended the public hearing with five people providing comments.
- <u>September 24, 2021, 9:00 a.m.</u> Seven members of the public attended the public hearing with no oral comments provided.
- In addition, 46 written comments were submitted to the Department.
