Agency Initiative Background


Problem Statement

- Oregon is experiencing an increased severity, complexity and duration of fire seasons, which has
- Challenged ODF's ability to respond to the wildfire workload and sustain its other core businesses, while
- Proactively protecting Oregonians, Forests and Communities from wildfire.

Addressing the Challenges

- The Agency is considering an Agency Initiative (Policy Option Package) for possible inclusion in our 2019-2021 request budget.
 - > 2016 Fire Program Review (sustainable organization workgroup)
 - > 2016 Secretary of State (performance audit)


ODF Protected Lands Average Acres Burned by Decade





Showing Average of Gross Costs for Years at Each Performance Level (%).




Fire Protection Related Hours All ODF Employees

Agency Initiative Framework General Fund Request

\$12 Million - 55 FTE

- 9 FTE Agency Administration Support Functions
- 10 FTE State Forests Response and Good Neighbor Authority
- 14 FTE Private Forests Urban Interface & Recovery
- 22 FTE Fire Protection Financials, Prevention, Training, Aviation, South Fork

\$5.6 Million Additional Severity

Annually: \$500,000 Local Contracting, \$500,000 1 Helitac (4 seasonal FTE), \$500,000 2 SEATS

(.5 seasonal FTE), \$1.3 Million for one Next Generation Tanker to replace existing Tanker

\$4.2 Million Cessna Grand Caravan EX Multi-Mission Aircraft

One time purchase

- **\$2.1 Million** Training all Agency Employees
- \$1.5 Million Type-2 Initial Attack Agency Crew (10.4 FTE)

\$25.4 Million: Total Request







Fire Activity Near Communities






No. of Fires vs. Acres Burned (Point of Origin)
