I. PROJECT SUMMARY:

Description of Project:

Project work consists of the construction of approximately 2800 ft. of trail to bypass a section of trail that is inconsistent with the difficulty rating of the connected route. A culvert on a non-fish seasonal stream will be installed on the bypass trail. The culvert will be sized to meet state and federal standards and the 100-year peak flow requirement. The culvert location and approaches will be designed to ensure hydrologic disconnection from aquatic resources. This project requires in-water work and will adhere to the timing restrictions defined in the ODFW In-Water Work Period Guidelines. The trail tread will be constructed 5' wide to accommodate motorcycles and quads. The trail will be surfaced using local pit-run rock sources. Project work will be completed by the REI OHV Trail Program staff using heavy equipment such as: mini-excavators, trail dozer, and tracked rock haulers.

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
