I. PROJECT SUMMARY:

Description of Project:

Project work consists of the vacation of the current trailhead, construction of new trailhead on ODF State Forest land, and trail construction to connect new trailhead to the existing trail network. Currently the existing trailhead is on private property and needs to be relocated. The new trailhead will be approximately 20'x40' and surfaced with crushed rock. New trail construction consists of approximately 0.33 miles of trail. Approximately 0.18 miles of mountain bike (MTB) trail will be constructed to connect the new trailhead to the existing trail network and 0.15 mi. of hiking only trail will be constructed to connect Shellburg Creek Trail to the Shellburg Falls Day Use Area. Trailhead rock needs will be sourced from the Stout Creek Rock Stockpile. Project work will be completed by ODF Recreation Staff and volunteers.


