


HISTORICAL TRENDS

Employment in the wood proudct sector is down 50% from the early 1990s





Employment in Oregon's Wood Product sectors largely flat over the past 8 years





Looking Forward

- Wood Products Manufacturing growth = 4% over the decade
 - -Sawmills and Wood preservation = -2%
 - -Plywood and engineered wood products = 7%
 - -Other Wood Products = 6%




Forestry, Logging, & Administrative of Conservation Programs
